

The Department of Criminal Justice Training has been selected to receive a special training grant to host a **40-hour**, K.L.E.C. approved training class:

**Class:** Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Symposium  
**Date:** November 26, 2012 thru November 30, 2012  
**Location:** Barren River Lake State Park and Resort

The class is open to all Kentucky law enforcement officers/deputies, any rank. The class will focus on the problems of Domestic Violence, Sexual Assault and Drug Facilitated Sexual Assaults. The class will be presented by nationally recognized guest trainers and staff members from the D.O.C.J.T.

The training grant permits the D.O.C.J.T. to offer lodging at the state park, free of charge to registered students who reside 40 miles or more from the training site. Students who stay at the resort will also receive a re-imbursement for meals, based on the current state per-diem rate and regulations.

Students shall register for this class by submitting a 29-1 through D.O.C.J.T. registration section.
