

# CVG police chief to head national association

The chief of the Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport's police department has been named president of the Airport Law Enforcement Agencies Network, an association of airport law enforcement agencies.

Chief Kevin Murphy will lead the group which includes more than 100 U.S. airports and numerous international members.

"I'm honored to hold this position and excited to serve an organization dedicated to the delivery of professional law enforcement and aviation security," Murphy said in a release. "I consider it recognition of the great work by my team and the other professionals here at CVG."

Murphy has worked at the department since 1992 and was named chief in 2005. He is also president of the Northern Kentucky Police Chief's Association.

He has also completed the FBI National Academy, the U.S. Secret Service Dignitary Protection Class and the Kentucky Department of Criminal Justice Training School of Strategic Leadership.
