

Due to factors outside of the control of the Department of Criminal Justice Training the Intoxilyzer 8000 recertification courses scheduled for 2013 have been suspended at this time.

The Department of Criminal Justice Training in consult with Justice and Public Safety Cabinet legal counsel has reviewed the requirements per KAR and KRS and found the following:

- Since the Intoxilyzer 8000 is not an approved instrument for Kentucky, officers are not required to maintain their certification on the instrument.
- If an officer's current certification on the 8000 expires and then goes to termination status they will not be required to attend the 40 hours *Basic Breath Test Operator* course. They will have to take the 4 hour 8000 recertification course.

Agencies will be notified when and where training will be conducted once the Intoxilyzer 8000 is approved for use in Kentucky and the instruments are in the field.
