The Boone County Sheriff's Department will be conducting a Basic Police Cyclist certification course during the week of May 23- 27, 2011 from 0800-1600 hours. The training will be conducted by International Police Mountain Bike Association (IPMBA) instructors, and upon successful completion of the course the officer will become an IPMBA certified cyclist. The site of the training will be the Boone County Sheriff's Department 3000 Conrad Lane Burlington, KY.

This training is accepted by Kentucky Law Enforcement Council (KLEC) to fulfill the 40 hr in-service requirements. The course is also Ohio Peace Officers Training Academy (OPOTA) certified training.

The training is rigorous, and the candidates SHOULD be in excellent physical condition to complete this course. Officers must provide his/her own mountain type bicycle to use during this training. Bikes should also be equipped with some sort of pedal retention. Road bikes are not acceptable due to off-road, and stair training. Large portions of this course will be conducted outdoors, so appropriate clothing should be available. Helmets, gloves, and eye protection are MANDATORY. The officers should also familiarize themselves with the bicycle beforehand to prepare for extended periods on the saddle.

The cost of the training is \$235.00. All classroom materials will be provided, and checks should be made out to "BOONE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT". Payment is due on or before the first day of class.
