### **Federal Funding Makes “Traumas of Law Enforcement” Possible in 2010**

A recent grant to C.O.P.S. from the Bureau of Justice Assistance, Office of Justice Programs, U.S. Department of Justice will fund the Traumas of Law Enforcement trainings in 2010 and 2011! The return of Federal funding for this project will enable C.O.P.S. to redirect the \$90,000+ cost for these trainings to other programs of the organization. In 2008, the funds for the trainings were taken from C.O.P.S.’ general account. In 2009, Streamlight®, GLOCK®, Harley-Davidson, the 100 Club of Houston, Texas, and the Indiana and Maryland Chapters of Concerns of Police Survivors contributed to meet the cost of the “Traumas” trainings.
